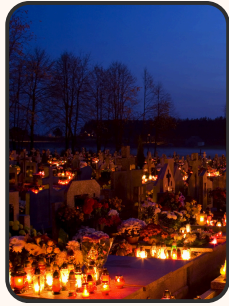
Day 3. The Nobility Day

Time to explore Poland's former royal capital! With a local guide, we will walk through the charming Old Town, visit the majestic Wawel Castle, and explore the fascinating underground museum beneath Kraków's Main Market Square. In the evening, we dine in one of Kraków's most atmospheric restaurants, soaking in the city's enchanting ambiance.



Day 6. Oświęcim – A Place of Remembrance

Today, we visit one of the world's most significant memorial sites – the Auschwitz-Birkenau Museum to learn about the tragic history of Holocaust. This deeply moving experience provides a profound understanding of 20th-century history. After returning to Kraków, we gather for a farewell dinner, sharing reflections and memories of our incredible journey.
